**Mecklenburg County Council will be offering a Fall and Spring ATV programs. You can schedule or get more information by contacting Joe Culpepper.**

ATV—This 8 hour class that will give the rider the opportunity to earn ASI Trained Rider Card and ride some of the camp trails. The class starts at 8:00 a.m. on Saturday. The cost for the 8 hour class and riding is \$60.00. You must be 14 years of age. If you are 14 years of age and less than 16 years of age, you can not weight more than 187 pounds and can not be more than 6 foot tall. You must also bring long pants, long sleeve shirt and boots that cover your ankles. Helmets, goggles, gloves , ATV and fuel will be provided. Each person must have their parents complete the two required permission slips. If a scout can not master the skill to move to the next level, he will be removed from the class with no refund. The ASI Camp instructor is the person who makes the final decision on a person ability to ride. ATV programs run rain or shine. Max class sizes is 6 or 8, depending on the age of the scouts. To hold a class, there must be 5 scouts in rolled. The troop must provide one leader over 21 years of age to take the class and ride with the class. There is no charge for the one adult. Part of the ride program is for scouts to learn and do maintenance on the ATV's.

After completion of the class, the scouts can register to ride for four hours on Sunday starting at 8:00 a.m. and ending at Noon. The cost is \$30.00 for the Sunday period. Any scouts who have completed the ASI Camp Class, can ride on this day.

Medical Forms — All scouts are required to have a complete BSA Medical From part A,B and C with them to show to the instructor.

Payments — All payments must be made at the Council Service center prior to the start of Camp Weekend. A copy of the receipt will need to be brought to camp.

Troop — Each troop will need to have two deep leadership in camp at all times. Each troop is responsible for their own food for the weekend. The dining hall will not be open Troop leader will need to logon to the MSR website and register for a camp site if the troop is staying over night..

Cancelations—Program are subject to be cancelled if the minimum number of scouts do not sign up for the program.
