

Mecklenburg Scout Reservation Usage Fees

The long range plan for Mecklenburg County Council, Boy Scouts of America is to have great camps with good program equipment. To insure funding to cover replacement cost, there will need to be some fees for use of camp and equipment.

The costs below are for periods outside of Summer Camp. Summer camp fees are covered in the Camp Grimes Leader's Guide found on the camp website, www.mycampgrimes.org.

All fees are due prior to or at the time of check-in. Fees are to be paid to the Camp Ranger or Camp Master. They will provide you with a receipt of your payment.

Camp General Fees – There is \$5.00 charge per night for campers (youth and adults) for use of any part of the camp by Out-of Council Boy Scouts of America or other non Boy Scouts of America organizations. There is no charge for in council troops, packs or crews.

Canoe and Trailer Off Camp Trip – In council and out-of-council troops, packs or crews can use the canoes and trailer for off camp property trips. The cost to use the canoe and trailer set is \$75.00 for in-council and \$150.00 for out-of-council for a weekend trip. The set includes 6 canoes, 12 paddles, and 12 PFDs. The trailer requires a 2 inch coupler. Individual canoes can be used for a fee of \$10.00 each for in council units and \$20.00 each for out-of-council units, and include 2 paddles and 2 PFDs per canoe.

Call the camp ranger to make arrangements to pick up canoes and trailer. The camp is closed on Sunday after 12 noon. The group using the canoes and trailer are responsible for cost of any damage and repairs.

Inside Structures with Cooking, Heat, or Water – These structures require additional costs to operate when in use. The fee for use of these structures is \$25.00 per day for both in council and out of council units. Structures subject to this fee are Kitchen, Dining Hall, Dick Carter Training Facility, Hornet's Nest building, Duplex, and the Senior Staff cabins.
